COLD WEATHER

SICKNESS POLICY

Please be mindful that if your child has a temperature of 38 or higher or is unwell to keep them at home. Please do not bring sick children into the setting so we can maintain the overall health of everyone in the setting. If your child is vomiting or has diarrhoea then they must not return until 48 hours after last bout. Antibiotics must be given for 48 hours prior to returning to the setting.



REMINDER OF TERMS

Please note that West Wight Nursery is open for 39 weeks per year and you sign up for this as a minimum. Holiday Club is available as an additional extra for parents who wish to use it. Sessions are booked and paid in advance.

Four weeks notice is required for permanent change of sessions or withdrawal from the setting—NOT to start back late into the term.

Fees must continue to be paid if your child is absent for any reason including appointments, illness, family holidays or any additional days off such as for a birthday etc
