We were donated some lovely items including a Hedgehog Hide, an outdoor nature camera and 10 log seats for the copse.

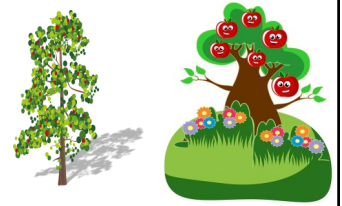


Queens Jubilee Tree Planting

If your child has sickness please leave 48 hrs after the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea before they return.

Guidelines are 48hrs from when they start a course antibiotics before they can return.

Fees must continue to be paid if your child is absent for any reason including appointments, illness, isolation due to covid, family holiday or any additional day off ie for a birthday.
