helping develop their hand-eye coordination.

They collected a variety of stones, looking at different shapes and sizes, discussing texture and colour.

Once back at the nursery, some of the children enjoyed painting a stone.



CAMPFIRE/FIRE SAFETY

The children commented that they could smell smoke outside from someone's bonfire, this led to a talk about fire safety.

The children decided they'd like to make a campfire so they walked up to the field and found some big logs that they wanted to use. Back at nursery they made pretend marshmallows and "toasted" them on their fire.



MATHS FOCUS USING TWEEZERS

This week the children used tweezers to pick up plastic counting bears and carefully place them into matching coloured containers. They recognised and sorted the bears by colour, showing an understanding of grouping. The children counted out loud as they placed each bear, demonstrating early number skills while also developing fine motor skills with the tweezers.
